#### **BABILI THE FARMER**

Babili and his friends Busa and Thula owned a farming business, located in Luyengo. They started the business ten years ago after obtaining a degree in agriculture. The main aim of the business was to grow vegetables and other crops which they sold to major retail outlets in the Manzini – Mbabane corridor. In addition to the qualification in Agriculture, the three friends studied Business Studies during their spare time in order to understand business operations.

The partners would from time to time disagree on issues pertaining to the running of the business. The disagreements worried Babili and as a result he resigned from the partnership with the aim of being a sole trader as he believed that he had entrepreneurial characteristics. He started his own farm business and worked towards growing it into a large agribusiness that does not concentrate on crop and vegetable production only. He knew clearly what he wanted his business to become and was willing to take certain risks to achieve his goals. He hired twelve farm workers and a manager during the first two years of operation. Babili understood that his business would affect different groups of people and that he would need more capital to finance the business.

He wanted to expand to overseas markets and intended to use his knowledge of technology to find markets abroad. He also had some experience in making payments using modern electronic banking facilities. Babili was aware that most vegetables that would be produced at the farm would be of limited supply yet the demand was very high.

Babili was also aware that there were Employer associations to which he could affiliate, as such he had taken time to research on employer associations and how they could assist him. He also studied a lot on the subject of motivation and demotivation since he believed that a motivated workforce was productive.
