This guide contains information on the 11 local colleges and universities that are eligible for the Government of Eswatini Student Loan Scheme. 1. LOCAL UNIVERSITIES / COLLEGES APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Ministry of Labour and Social Security, through the Pre-Service Tertiary Education and Training (PTET) Unit, is responsible for providing access to relevant quality Tertiary Education and Training institutions to all qualifying Emaswati through the PTET Study Loan program. The table below lists the courses eligible for this program, with a link provided to access other programs (including those not eligible for the government study loan scheme). Some courses not listed in the 2016 - 2020 Government Priority List have been included *in italics* on the table, for the information of the reader. To apply, visit <https://www.slas.gov.sz/>. All questions must be directed to the Ministry of Labour.

Credit: A credit is a result which is C or better

Pass: A pass is a result which is E or better

Points: This is the sum of points for the best 6 subjects obtained by a student in their results

- Students need to be aware that when applying, they need to submit certain information that accompanies the main application form, whether on the online application system, email application or hard copies delivered at the institution. This information is usually the proof payment for the application fee, and certified copies of results and national ID. Other institutions such as SANU may require other information such as testimonial letters and medical records. Students are encouraged to make copies of the certified documents, as well as scan and keep them in the cloud for safekeeping and ease of applying. TKI recommends students to sign up for a Gmail email account on mail.google.com, which comes with a complementary 15GB cloud storage on Google Drive linked to their email.
